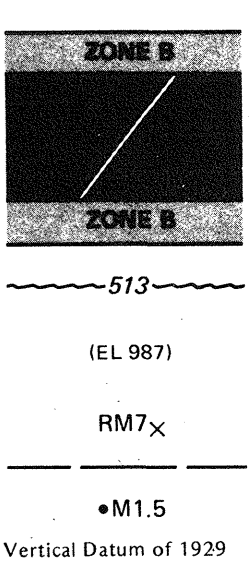

***EXPLANATION OF ZONE DESIGNATIONS**

| ZONE | EXPLANATION |
|--------|--|
| A | Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined. |
| A0 | Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; average depths of inundation are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined. |
| AH | Areas of 100-year shallow flooding where depths are between one (1) and three (3) feet; base flood elevations are shown, but no flood hazard factors are determined. |
| A1-A30 | Areas of 100-year flood; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined. |
| A99 | Areas of 100-year flood to be protected by flood protection system under construction; base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined. |
| B | Areas between limits of the 100-year flood and 500-year flood; or certain areas subject to 100-year flooding with average depths less than one (1) foot or where the contributing drainage area is less than one square mile; or areas protected by levees from the base flood. (Medium shading) |
| C | Areas of minimal flooding. (No shading) |
| D | Areas of undetermined, but possible, flood hazards. |
| V | Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors not determined. |
| V1-V30 | Areas of 100-year coastal flood with velocity (wave action); base flood elevations and flood hazard factors determined. |

NOTES TO USER

Certain areas not in the special flood hazard areas (zones A and V) may be protected by flood control structures. This map is for flood insurance purposes only; it does not necessarily show all areas subject to flooding in the community or all planimetric features outside special flood hazard areas. | REFERENCE MARKS | ELEVATION FEET (NGVD) | DESCRIPTION OF LOCATION |
|-----------------|-----------------------|---|
| RM 66 | 759.31 | Mark set in the top of a concrete post projecting 0.7 foot above the ground located 4 poles east of milepost no. 295-30 on the Missouri Pacific Railroad, 54.0 feet southwest of a battery signal box, 23.0 feet south of the south rail, 15.0 feet north of the centerline of a trail, 6.7 feet west of a telephone pole. |
| RM 67 | 760.76 | Mark set in the west end of the south headwall of concrete culvert under the Missouri Pacific track, 1-1/2 poles west of milepost no. 294-30, 13.0 feet south of the south rail of the Missouri Pacific track, 1.2 feet east of the west end of the headwall. |
| RM 68 | 755.23 | Mark set in the west end of the south headwall of a concrete culvert under the Missouri Pacific track, 12.5 feet south of the south rail of the track, 1.0 foot east of the west end of the headwall, and about 5.0 feet below track level, 1 pole west of milepost no. 294. |
| RM 69 | 761.23 | Mark set in top of wingwall at the northeast end of the southeast headwall of concrete culvert under the oiled road, located at crossing of railed and oiled road, 44.0 feet southeast of railroad bridge no. 74A, 39.0 feet west of milepost 292/10, 36.0 feet south of south rail, 10.0 feet southeast of the centerline of oiled road. |
